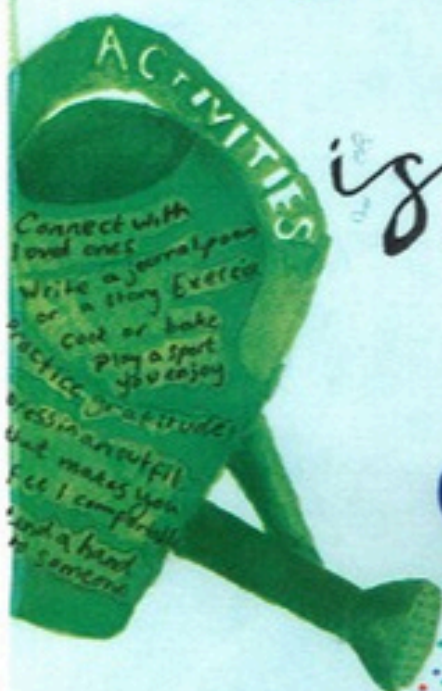

IMPORTANT DEADLINE REMINDERS

YEAR 10 WORK EXPERIENCE: The deadline for students to self place is **Friday 19th December**. Students are encouraged to find their own placement, to ensure suitability and preference of the experience.

YEAR 11 COLLEGE / PROVIDER APPLICATIONS: The deadline to apply for at least one provider is **Friday 19th December**. Applications are submitted via the college/provider web site, a course discussion will follow to secure the student's place for September entry.

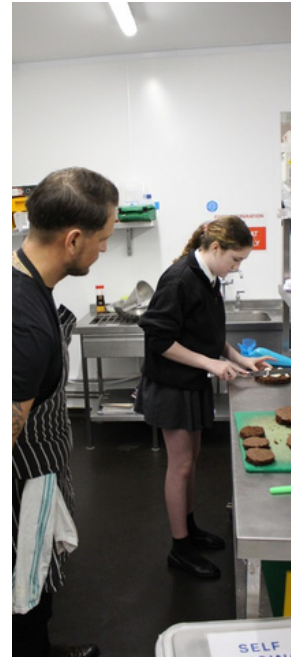
The event left students feeling inspired and informed, with a deeper understanding of how to prepare for future career opportunities. We look forward to more events like this to help students shape their career paths!

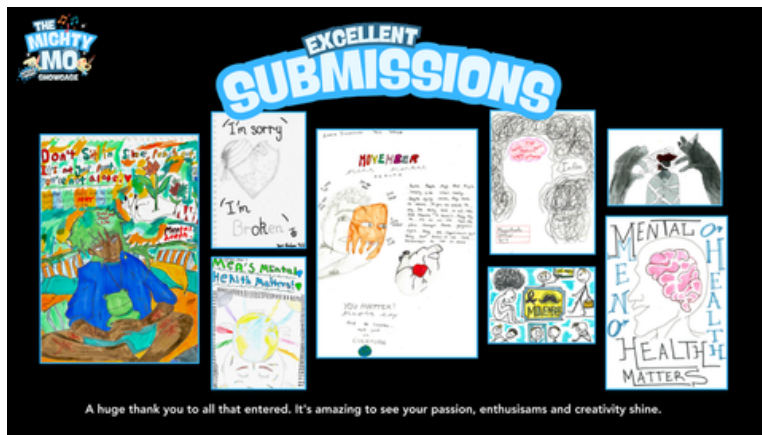

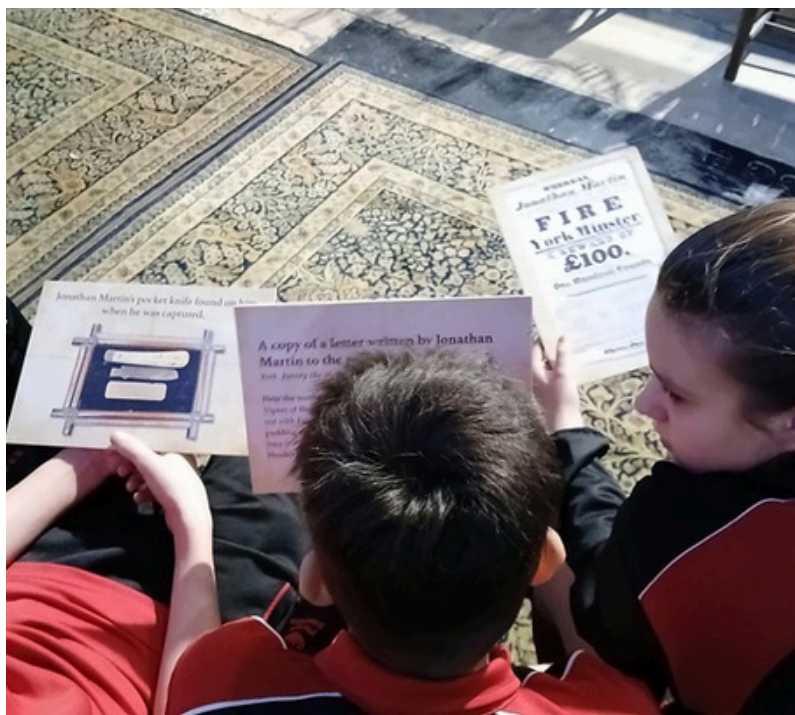
